### **OFFICIAL COMPETITION RULES**

COMPLETED ENTRY FORM(S) AND FEES MUST BE RECEIVED BY SATURDAY APRIL 22, 2012. LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE JUDGED, BUT MAY BE PUT ON DISPLAY FOR SHARING.

ENTRY DELIVERY AND SET-UP WILL BE SUNDAY APRIL 29 2012, 9:30 - 10:30 am.

There is NO theme for this show, choose anything you want as long as it is tasteful.

1. Please review all categories, divisions and rules prior to completing your entry. To determine the correct division: read the division descriptions on the entry form, find your experience level and then complete the form.
2. All entries must be the SOLE work of the contestant. This includes all flowers, decorations, pearls, jewels, etc. Styrofoam dummies may be used, but must be reproducible in cake form. The use of plastic is discouraged (except for support). In the case of a CHILD ENTRY all work MUST BE COMPLETED BY THE CHILD ONLY.
3. **ENTRIES MUST BE FOOTED** to facilitate handling and minimize damage. (Ideas: Use a cake divider plate; glue small pieces of Styrofoam on bottom of cake board; or use plastic pushpins.)
4. **Your entire entry must be limited to a maximum of 24" x 24". It can be smaller but not larger. Larger entries will be disqualified! NO "inspiration" pieces or other items are allowed.**

5. Entries must be prepared for the CCCSAS Cake Show only OR HAVE NOT BEEN IN A PREVIOUSLY JUDGED SHOW. Confections that HAVE WON in previous competitions are invited to be displayed. "Display only" items are welcome for the enjoyment and appreciation of others.
6. The Cake Show Committee reserves the right to re-categorize, refuse (if inappropriate), and/or disqualify entries as necessary.
7. By signing the entry form the contestant:
  - A. Gives permission to have their entry photographed. Photographs may be used at the Club's discretion.
  - B. Agrees to hold no one responsible if his/her entry is damaged or stolen.
  - C. States their entry has not been in any previously judged show.
  - D. Agrees that entry **will be disposed of** if not claimed by 5:00 pm April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2012.

- **COMMITTEE DECISIONS ON CATEGORY CHANGES OR DISQUALIFICATIONS ARE FINAL.**
- **ALL AWARDS AND DECISIONS OF THE JUDGES ARE FINAL.**
- **NO ONE OTHER THAN THE COMPETITOR is allowed in the judging area at drop-off time. Children and one adult will be allowed to place entry.**
- **You will have no more than the time required to set down your entry in the judging area.**

Entry Repairs - A small area will be available for you to do repairs. Repairs must be completed by 10:15 am and your entry placed by 10:30am when judging begins. Bring your own supplies!

## **Awards**

1. First, Second, and Third place will be awarded in each category and division.
2. BEST OF SHOW - One best of show entry will be selected from the first place winner of all categories.

- Advanced (400)**  
has had 4 years but less than 6 years decorating experience or has won first place in intermediate division in CCCSAS.
- Intermediate (300)**  
has had 2 years but less than 4 years decorating experience or has won first place amateur in CCCSAS.
- Amateur (200)**  
Contestant has had less than 2 years decorating experience as an adult.
- Culinary Student (100)**  
Must be a current culinary student.
- Children (700)**  
Circle one age 5-7 8-10 11-13 14-17
